THE PUNJAB APPROPRIATION BILL, 2021

A

BILL

to authorize the payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab, for the services and purposes during the financial year 2020-2021.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Punjab in the Seventysecond Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Punjab Appropriation Act, 2021.

1. ssue of 65236773000/-

out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab for the financial year, 2020-2021.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab, there may be paid and applied sums, not exceeding those, specified in column 5 of the Schedule, appended to this Act, amounting, in the aggregate to a sum of `65236773000/- (Rupees Six Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Three Crore Sixty Seven lac and Seventy Three Thousand only) towards defraying several charges, which will come in the course of payment to be made during the financial year, 2020-2021 in respect of the services and purposes, specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums, authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes, specified in the said Schedule, in relation to the financial year 2020-2021.

Overriding effect

of the Act

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other Act for the time being in force, the provisions of this Act shall prevail.
