## 2. Walk Out

- 1. All the Members of Aam Aadmi Party present in the House except Sardar Sukhpal Singh Khaira, Sardar Nazar Singh Manshahia, Sardar Kanwar Sandhu, Prof. Baljinder Kaur, Sardar Pirmal Singh Dhaula, Sardar Jagdev Singh Kamalu, Sardar Gurmeet Singh Meet Haher and Sardar Amarjit Singh Sandoa staged a walkout from the House raising anti-govt. slogans as a mark of protest for not taking action against concerned officials responsible for not implementing the 85th amendment in the State.
- 2. All the Members of Shiromani Akali Dal present in the House except Sardar Parminder Singh Dhindsa staged a walkout from the House raising anti-govt. slogans as a mark of protest on the demand of reducing VAT on diesel and petrol.
